High School Program Details ...

To meet district diploma requirements, students must acquire 23.0 credits (24 credits for class of 2020) approved by Vancouver Public Schools. Students should expect to spend a minimum of 5 hours per week for each credit course. Students will be enrolled in six classes. Classes are two days per week.

If a student does not have a scheduled class during a period they are required to report to the computer lab to work on assignments, online classes, and contracted Edmodules.

Middle School Program Details ...

All classes are two days per week, but require substantial time at home facilitated by the parent partners to complete course objectives. Grade 7 - 8 students may be enrolled in up to 14 hours of classes onsite each week, including enrichment, (Friday) classes.

^{**}Running Start students must be enrolled in a minimum of one onsite course. If no courses are scheduled onsite the student must enroll at the neighborhood high school.
