Grade 1-8 Enrichment Program Details . . .

All classes are one day per week and are full year. Classes do not require time at home to complete course objectives.

High School CTE Details . . .

Health, Food and Fitness, Child Development I and II, Real Life 101, Computer Applications, Next Tools, Financial Algebra and Web Design are Career and Technical Education courses. (CTE) These courses are part of each grades course of study and may be used to satisfy the 1.0 occupational education credit for high school graduation. Students are required to attend the scheduled class on Fridays. Classroom activities will be completed during the scheduled time. Additional assignments will be provided for completion at home.

High School Offsite Course Details . . .

World Themes, U.S. History, CWP and PE are all courses that will be completed in an online or contracted learning environment. Student progress will be monitored and grading finalized by a VHC teacher. Significant parent oversight is necessary for student success in online courses.
